**Dennis Jones** enjoyed a 30-year career with Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD), where he worked at Brazos Bend State Park and then as Park Lead Interpreter at the San Jacinto Monument. He moved to Florida for a time and then returned to the San Jacinto Monument, his last assignment before retirement from TPWD. Earlier in his career, Dennis worked at Armand Bayou Nature Center, at C.H.E.M.T.R.E.C. in Washington, D.C., and at The Smithsonian Institution. Currently, as Coastal Warden, Upper Coast, Audubon Texas Coastal Conservation Program, Dennis is responsible for bird-breeding islands managed by Audubon Texas along the upper Texas Coast. He has taught “Introduction to Ornithology” as part of Audubon’s Bird Nerd series.
