Action Register: Dave

• Contract with Pearland Parks, Recreation, and Wildlife: Pete Romfh reported that the contract for the development of a nature center is being revised to provide for an annual review.



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- Finalize Celebrations: Pam West has received 64 responses for the celebration, but will plan for 80 attendees. Ed Barrios will prepare a slide show. Tables and chairs from the Sea Center will be set up by volunteers: Dave, Roy, Leo, and Jerry. Discussion followed regarding the cost for using the pavilion. Jerry suggested purchasing paver stones. Roy moved, seconded by Pete that we take \$150 out of the treasury to purchase the stones. The motion carried.
- Volunteer Management System Update: Jerry Eppner reported that Texas Parks and Wildlife requires that everyone login and post volunteer time in the new VMS system. TNM-COT is in the third tier for implementation. Our contact is Bradley James. The set-up into the system requires obtaining profile data for all members since inception; i.e. addresses, telephone numbers, etc. Dave and Jerry will work to auto upload profiles for volunteers.
 The first step should be getting the upload done; then training for administrators. The training for most volunteers should be seamless, but connection to the internet is essential. The big change is the 45-day reporting requirement. The system will not accept dates that are more than 45 days old. Also Advanced and Volunteer Training projects prior to September 1, 2015 will have to be setup as acceptable projects. A date needs to be set up for training. It was pointed out that the state does not allow travel time to AT events to count. Clarification needs to be determined if travel time can count for VT hours.
- Media Library Move: Neal McLain reported that a room at the end of the hall is available as a volunteer room for the media library. The Master Gardeners have a computer available for our use. Also there will be a bookcase with open shelves for our books. After discussion it was agreed to put our books on the shelves in the volunteer room. Also, Ed has agreed to take the "Petersen Field Guides" to the "Taste of Nature" silent auction.
