Programs: Leo Novak reported that Mike Mullins will make a presentation at the October General Meeting entitled "Can We Make a Difference with Small Acreage Tracts?" Also, the AT program will be "Improving Southern Flounder Management



Through Characterization of Habitat Effects on Juvenile Sex Ratios," presented by Dr. Lindsay Glass Campbell.

Jerry Eppner, Membership Coordinator, reported that approximately 60 members have tried the VMS system with 85% – 90% good entries. We are currently at 12,390 VT and 13.074 AT hours.

Ed Barrios, State Representative, reported that Michelle Haggerty, State Coordinator for Texas Master Naturalists is planning a video phone conference to conduct the first quarterly state meeting with the chapter state representatives. It was pointed out that many chapters do not have a designated representative, and many designate their past president as the state representative. Connie Stolte, Chapter Advisor, reported that in a phone conversation with Michelle Haggerty, she was told that all comments regarding the by-laws would be reviewed and forwarded to the state committee. The membership will vote on the changes in November.
