President: Dave Brandes reminded us to think about possible nominations to replace members leaving the board and to consider if you would be willing to fill a vacant position.

Past-President: Mike Mullins showed an example of the proposed gift, a tumbler, for current members and for future presenters. The tumbler will celebrate the chapter's 15 year anniversary this year on September 14, 2016. The color of the 16 ounce tumbler will be silver with a forest green logo and will include, on one side, the COT logo and the words "Since 2001." An initial order will be made for 216 tumblers.

- August 10 General Meeting: Darrin Griffith, assistant supervisor at Brazoria County Mosquito Control, discussing 'Brazoria County Mosquito Control Presents the Mosquito'.
- September 14 General Meeting: Deborah January-Bevers, President and CEO of Houston Wilderness, discussing the 10 area ecoregions and their Ecosystem Primer program.
- October 12 General Meeting: Ed Craven, President of Armand Bayou Nature Center, discussing his work with the Cornell Lab of Ornithology on the Ivory-billed woodpecker and other birds.

Jill also stated that she would be happy to continue to book speakers for next year.

Secretary: Jean Britt announced that she will no longer continue as Secretary for the 2017 year.

Treasurer's Report: Don Sabathier showed the Board a summary spreadsheet he had prepared with monthly revenue and expenses for June 2016 and presented the June Treasurer's report. Don projected more expenditures for August and September.

State Meeting Photo Contest setup and Staffing: Barbara Burkhardt stated that she would not be attending the annual state TMN meeting this year and requested help with the Photo Contest at the meeting. A discussion followed. It was decided that we would provide easels and display boards if transportation is available for the transport of said items. We will no longer participate in the administering of the photo contest.

next year. She also asked Mike Mullins to pass out the 'Nature Trackers' brochures at the next General Meeting.

Chapter Host: Pam West reported that the 15th year TMN celebration event will be held on September 14, 2016 at the Lake Jackson Civic Center. The rooms will be rented from 8 am to 2 pm. Members may bring a guest. The meeting will begin at 9:00 and the guest speaker at 10:15. Following this, a potluck meal will be served.
