State Representative: Ed Barrios will send out a spread sheet requesting volunteers for the Brazoria National Wildlife Refuge 50th anniversary to be held on November 12, 2016. Volunteer Service Coordinator: Pete Romfh reported that GCBO has received a grant to remove invasive species. In addition, GCBO has received a grant for the MOTUS network.
