**Communications Director**—Larry Peterson stated that there was no substantial activity. The State Office has provided dates for web software updates.

**Chapter Advisor(s)**—Paul Cason said that Sea Center Texas is working on a plan to reopen on a limited basis (and with staff only) at the end of May.

John O'Connell said that Brazoria County announced the option of bringing staff back as of May 4 and fully opening on May 11. AgriLIFE Extension Service is reviewing in-person meeting policy on May 8. He added that the TMN Coastal Prairie and Galveston Bay Area Chapters have been holding new member training virtually.
