Examples of approved volunteer activities:

- Locate & identify specimens of currently unrepresented or under-represented Texas native plants
- Make high quality photographs documenting plant structure & appearance
- Create high resolution image files for submission
- Record required data in MS Excel Spreadsheet from Wildflowers.org
- Electronically submit images and data for publication
- Communicate with Collections Manager and staff as needed
