**Project Description**

*Locate, identify, and document lady beetles in the Mid-Gulf region for submission to the **Lost Ladybug Project** of Cornell University*

**Examples of approved volunteer activities:**

- Locate & identify specimens of lady beetles observed or collected in native settings
- Make one or more high quality photographs documenting appearance and key features such as the pronotum
- Create image files for submission. Image size must be < 2 Mb
- Record required data in ‘Data and Photo Submission Form’ located on lostladybug.org web site <http://www.lostladybug.org/form/page-1-form-558.php> or use the LLP app to submit photo and data
- Electronically submit images and data for publication
- Communicate with Lost Ladybug contact if needed to complete submission

*As a guideline, members may count ¼ hour of VT for up to two correctly formatted and identified photos of each lady beetle along with the associated submission form submitted to the lostladybug website.*

*While most of the field work for this effort will likely be concurrent with other, unrelated, activities, participants may record UP TO two(2) hours per week for locating, identifying and photographing specimens for submission if the time has not already been included in other volunteer activity.*
